Responsibilities

~ Grade Submission

Your order should include a form called a Student Grade Report (SGR). This form needs to be completed in its entirety, including attendance, course numbers, and signature box. Record ALL your grades on this form, Studyguide grades, Weekly Quiz grades, Quarter Test grades, and Project grades. Be sure to average the grades properly to figure the quarter and semester grades. A sample SGR is provided on page 4 of this packet, and an in-depth guide to scoring and figuring grades is available in the Homeschool Guide.

The Student Grade Report should be submitted twice a school year. Once after the first semester is completed, and again after the second semester is completed. CAT tests will be automatically sent to the student after the first semester SGR is received.

It is important to be sure to complete the entire Student Grade Report, including the course number, attendance, and signature box at the bottom along with all the grades.

Partially completed Student Grade Reports will not be processed and will be returned to the parent. Properly and entirely completed SGRs will ensure records and report cards are accurate in the student's file here at LCA. In order to protect the integrity of our accreditation status, we consider your signature on these documents to be a legal affidavit stating that you have truthfully and accurately evaluated the information reported.

All students from 1st grade through 12th grade will be provided with report cards each semester. Once we receive the Student Grade Reports we will process the grades and generate a report card. The report card will then be mailed to you typically within 1 week of being received by us.

~Grade Submission Deadlines

Students enrolling in the Academy have 12 months to complete the school year. The start date is assumed to be the date Academy Enrollment was purchased, unless another start date is given by the parent. Because of how we operate, there is some flexibility on the grade submission deadlines.

Families who are following the traditional school year time-line can use the following submission dates as general guidelines for staying on track to complete the school year in 9 months.

First Semester submission date: January 15

Second Semester submission date: June 15

Some students may be starting at different times during the school year and should adjust these dates accordingly in order to still finish within 12 months.

~ Local Home School Laws

Each parent/teacher is responsible for abiding by the homeschool laws of their state of residence. Each state has different requirements for homeschoolers and LCA is not responsible to make sure each student is meeting these requirements which may include annual paperwork, required subjects, attendance, etc. A good resource for this information is www.youcanhomschool.com

~ High School Graduation Planning

LCA follows a graduation plan (included) that may be personalized when needed to ensure that the student satisfies the requirements of the State of Florida. Students must also fulfill the High School requirements from their state of residence. A good resource for this information is www.youcanhomschool.com

~ Annual Achievement Testing

Annual achievement testing is required for all academy students in 1st -11th grade. No testing is required for 12th grade. The cost is included in the annual academy fee. LCA uses the California Achievement Test (CAT) from 1970. The test is administered by the parent and graded by certified scorers. CAT results will be recorded in the students cumulative file, and provided to the parents. The test and instructions will automatically be mailed with the student's 1st semester report card.

Transcripts/Diploma

High school academy students have a transcript maintained throughout their high school years. This can be sent at any time to colleges, employers, or other institutions for a small fee.

Upon completion of the high school requirements, a student will receive a high school diploma. The diploma and tassel can be mailed to the student or presented at our annual graduation ceremony here in Haines City, FL.

V730 Principles of Music

Principles of Music is required to fulfill the Fine Arts credit.

MU Music Lessons

A student may take music lessons to replace Principles of Music and fulfill the needed Fine Arts Credit. A Music Lesson Log is available free of charge. The student is required to record their practice times and the teacher calculate a grade every quarter. At the end of the school year the packet will be turned in the Academy to be added to the Transcript.

PE Physical Education

One credit of Physical Education is required to be taken during the High School years of a student. A Physical Education Packet is available free of charge. Students may choose activities (running, biking, walking, swimming, etc.) and turn in the completed log for one credit of P.E. Credit can be taken once during any year of high school.

High School Electives

Landmark Freedom Baptist Curriculum offers a selection of elective credits for high school students to choose from to complete their high school education. Students may need a specific elective to meet the requirements in their state of residence. Electives may also be chosen by parents who are interested in their student learning a specific subject, or by the student according to their interests.
